



# Update Regarding Tuition Fees

## Tuition Payment Plan Option for Winter 2021

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We recognize that COVID-19 has presented challenges for students, including unanticipated financial pressures. Therefore, we have established a tuition payment plan for the Winter 2021 semester.

The payment plan is available to new and returning domestic students and returning international students.

Students can pay their Winter 2021 semester tuition in full on December 14, 2020, or in three instalments, due on the following dates:

- First Instalment – December 14, 2020
- Second Instalment – January 22, 2021
- Third Instalment – February 19, 2021

### How to sign up for the tuition payment plan

Students can sign up for the Winter 2021 semester tuition payment plan on [STU-VIEW](#). The form will be available November 16, 2020 – January 22, 2021. Students must be registered for winter programs to qualify.

## Athletics Ancillary Fees Waived for Winter 2021

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Given that the college's buildings are closed, and students are not able to access the Athletics & Recreation facilities, the college will waive the Athletics & Recreation and the Athletics Building Capital fees (\$78 per student) for Winter 2021 semester, as it did for the Spring and Fall 2020 semesters. All other fees will continue to be charged, since services continue to be offered to students.

## Student Association Ancillary Fees Reduced for Winter 2021 (NEW)

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The Student Association Board of Directors has decided cohesively to reduce the \$114.78 Student Association Fee by \$18.05 for the Winter 2021 semester only. This reduction pertains to the Safewalk program and Capital amounts.

Full-time students enrolled in the Winter 2021 semester will receive a refund/credit of \$18.05 if they have already paid the Student Association Fee.

## Minimum Deposit Amount Reduced for Winter 2021

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In recognition of the continuing financial pressures caused by COVID-19, we have reduced the minimum tuition deposit fee for the winter semester by 50 per cent. **This reduced deposit fee does not affect your tuition amount.**

New students who wish to register for the winter semester will now be expected to pay the following non-refundable deposit by November 9, 2020. Please refer to your Registration/Invoice Letter for specific instructions.

- Domestic Students – \$250 deposit (previously \$500)
- Returning International Students – \$2,000 deposit (previously \$4,000)

Please note: New international students are still required to pay the full first semester fees to accept their offer and confirm their registration.

## Payment Options

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### Pay online using a credit card

- Log in to your [STU-VIEW](#) account and select **Registration Services > Registration > View/Pay Fees**

### Pay through online/telephone banking, or in person at your bank:

- Please select "GEORGE BROWN COL.-CUR.YR.-TUITION" as the payee. Your student ID is your account number.
- **Please note:** It can take 3-5 business days for the College to receive payments made by these methods. Payments must be received by the published due date.

## Pay with Aeroplan® Miles through the HigherEdPoints.com program

- George Brown College is now partnered with the [HigherEdPoints.com](https://HigherEdPoints.com) program which allows students, family members, and friends to redeem their Aeroplan® miles to pay for their education at George Brown College.
- Through this program, Aeroplan® members can redeem their miles and convert them in \$250 increments to offset the cost of college. (35,000 Aeroplan® Miles = \$250)
- Once the transfer is received from HigherEdPoints.com, it will appear on your student account at GBC within 2-3 business days as a **non-refundable** cash deposit.
- **Please note:** You can **only** convert Aeroplan® Miles online through [HigherEdPoints.com](https://HigherEdPoints.com), not at the front counter or via the other payment options. Payments posted towards your tuition are non-refundable.
