Fee Name	Amount	Description
Counselling	\$12.16 per semester	To assist in the provision of services and programs to support student mental health and wellbeing.
Career Service	\$12.16 per semester	To assist in the provision of services and programs to support student career development and planning.
Tutoring & Learning	\$12.16 per semester	To assist in the provision of services and programs to support academic skill development and tutoring.
Athletics	\$45.92 per semester	To assist in the provision of varsity athletics programming and services, and programs that support student physical health and wellbeing. <i>This fee has been waived for the Fall 2020 and Winter 2021 semesters.</i>
Athletics Capital	\$32.11 per semester	To support capital and operating expenses for student athletics and recreation facilities. <i>This fee has been waived for the Fall 2020 and Winter 2021 semesters.</i>
Academic Technology Support	\$94.50 per semester	To assist in the provision of digital tools and technologies to support student learning.
ID Card	\$12.00 Charged once in Semester 1	To assist in the provision of the student identification card and systems.
Convocation	\$58.73 Charged once in Semester 1	To assist in the provision of annual convocation and graduation activities, and production of final diplomas, certificates and degrees.
